Reception-Year 5 Water Safety/Swim Program at the Gawler Pool

The Water Safety/Swim Program for students from Reception to Year 5 commences on Monday 23rd March, with the final lesson on Friday 27th March.

This program, together with the Aquatics Program (Year 6 - Port Vincent), are part of the schools Physical Education program. These programs give students an opportunity to strengthen their water confidence and further develop their skills. For the Reception - Yr 5 sessions your child's teacher will be monitoring the children throughout their lesson and will be monitoring the changerooms throughout the sessions.

Students will receive an information letter next week which provides explicit direction re policy/procedures and includes a time-table showing departure and arrival times for each of the R-5 classes as well as lesson times.
