#### **SCHOOL FEES**

At the Freeling Primary School Governing Council meeting held on Tuesday 29th October @ 7:00pm, the schedule of school and preschool fees as previously published was approved unopposed for the 2025 school year.

#### **ENTERPRISE AFTERNOON – UPPER PRIMARY**

This is a great opportunity for the upper primary students to test out their creativity and business skills, and the younger students to practise making financial choices and using money. The Upper Primary classes have been busy creating their items for sale. Items will range from 50c - \$7 (cash only).

#### **TRANSITION VISITS**

The school year is rapidly nearing the end, and we are looking forward to meeting and welcoming our new enrolments in the preschool next year, as well as welcoming new students in our Reception classes at the commencement of 2025. To help reduce any anxiety children have in starting preschool/school next year, we have organised two transition visits so they can meet their teacher and experience a taste of their new classroom/environment. Parents of our current preschool enrolments who have children commencing school in 2025 would have already received information regarding these visits. If you have not already completed an Enrolment Form for Freeling Primary School or received a Parent Information Booklet, please call at the Front Office to ensure you have these items.

Completed enrolment forms need to be returned to the Front Office of the Freeling Primary School before your child arrives for their first transition visit.

The first transition morning is scheduled for Wednesday the 27<sup>th</sup> of November with a parent information session at 9:00am in the Staff Room for parents of new Reception students; providing an opportunity for parents to meet Angela Jenkins (Principal) and Luke Shepley (Deputy Principal) and to ask any questions in preparation for your child starting school. The second transition visit is set for Wednesday the 4<sup>th</sup> of December. Communication is being sent home over the next week as to which of these two dates children starting preschool in 2025 will be attending their transition. Reception students will be attending transition from 9:00am until 1:30pm; Preschool transition will be from 9:00am until 11:00am. Just a reminder, if you intend for your child to attend school transition on a day that is not their regular preschool day, they will need to be dropped off at the classroom at 9:00am and collected from the classroom at 1:30pm. If they are only attending school transition on their regular preschool day, preschool staff will collect children at 1:30pm and return them to the preschool.


School & Preschool Fees School Card Applications

#### REMEMBRANCE DAY - 11/11/2024

#### What is Remembrance Day?

On the 11th hour on the 11th day of the 11th month, a minute's silence is observed and dedicated to those soldiers who died fighting to protect the nation.

At 11am on 11 November 1918, the guns on the Western Front fell silent after more than four years of continuous warfare. The Germans called for an armistice (suspension of fighting) in order to secure a peace settlement. They accepted the allied terms of unconditional surrender.

Originally known as Armistice Day, it was renamed Remembrance Day after World War Two to commemorate those who were killed in both World Wars.

Today the loss of Australian lives from all wars and conflicts is commemorated on Remembrance Day.

We will remember them. Lest we forget.



4 students from our year 6 cohort and the Reception students from Room 2 (Mrs Gardner), will attend the Freeling commemorative service at the Cenotaph on Monday 11/11/2024, representing Freeling Primary School. The remainder of our classes will hold their annual Remembrance Day commemoration on the lawn area adjacent to our flag poles at the front of the school. This tribute will be led by some of our older students.

### WRITING AT FREELING PRIMARY

The following are snippets from some of the student's writing.



## Register now for reception in 2025!



In South Australia, the first year of primary school is called reception. Children who turn 5 years old:

- before 1 May can start school in term 1
- between 1 May and 31
   October can start school in term 3 (mid-year intake)
- after 31 October can start the next year.

Children who start school at the beginning of the year will complete 4 terms of reception.

Children who start school in a mid-year intake will complete 6 terms of reception.



#### Register your interest for 2025

Registrations of interest are now open to start school in 2025. If your child is starting school in term 1 or term 3, you are encouraged to submit your registration of interest by the end of term 2, 2024.


